

# YOUR FIRST VISIT TO THE LODGE

I. **ADDRESS:** 855 MAIN ST, (ROUTE 131) PROCTORSVILLE, VT

**PHONE:** (802) 226-7010

**DIRECTIONS:** I-91 NORTH TO VERMONT, EXIT 6. LEFT AT END OF RAMP ON TO ROUTE 103. STAY ON ROUTE 103 (IN CHESTER, ROUTE 103 TURNS TO THE RIGHT). TURN RIGHT ON TO ROUTE 131 INTO PROCTORSVILLE AND GO EXACTLY ONE MILE. THE VERMONT HOUSE IS ON THE LEFT SIDE OF ROAD, ACROSS FROM THE CATHOLIC CHURCH.

## II. What to Bring:

- A. Pillows are provided. Bring twin-sized bed linens/blankets or sleeping bag.
- B. Personal toiletries (towel, soap, toothpaste, etc). Earplugs recommended for light sleepers.
- C. Sleeping attire/loungewear that is suitable to a co-ed environment. (There is one female-only bedroom).
- D. Food: A Continental Breakfast (coffee, juice, cereal, bread, pastries, etc) is provided on the weekends. You are responsible for your own lunches and on most weekends, for your own dinners. Most members go out for dinner however, we sometimes pool our culinary talents and have a community dinner. Members are always welcome to use the kitchen facilities but are responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their guests, including washing, drying and putting dishes away. REMEMBER-YOUR MOTHER ISN'T THERE TO CLEAN UP AFTER YOU!!

## III. Upon Your Arrival:

- A. Pull up next to the side entrance to unload your car. After you are done, park in the rear of the building. DO NOT PARK IN THE AREA DIRECTLY TO THE REAR OF THE DRIVEWAY, AS THIS IS WHERE THE SNOW PLOW PUSHES THE SNOW!
- B. The room assignments will be posted in the hall entranceway. All skis must be stored in the barn, which can be accessed through the bar room. You may store food in the refrigerator on the left side of the kitchen. (The other frig is for lodge staples). There is another frig located in the bar room for beverages. IMPORTANT: LABEL AND DATE ALL OF YOUR FOOD AND DRINK. ANYTHING WHICH IS NOT LABELED IS UP FOR GRABS! ALSO PLEASE REMOVE ALL OF YOUR FOOD/DRINK FROM REFRIGERATORS AT THE END OF YOUR STAY!
- C. If you owe any money/vouchers and have not made prior arrangements with Lisa Durland, please settle with the Lodge Innkeeper.

## IV. Lodge Etiquette:

- A. Absolutely NO SMOKING!!!! Anyone found smoking anywhere in the house, barn or on the porch will be asked to leave immediately!!
- B. Maid service is not provided; clean up after yourself (and your guests). Please be considerate of others and wipe down bathroom sinks and counters and clean your dishes.
- C. Our heating/electric bills are enormous! Please treat the Lodge as if it was your own house, and turn off lights, tv, stereo, close outside doors, etc.
